NAT	National racing license, qualification through a 2-day NSK-recognized license training course or 4 classifications at REG or LOC events within the last 2 years. License fees: CHF 290.00 (CHF 640.00 including all mandatory fees)

FIA HRCP	No expiration date. FIA vehicle passport for historic regularity races, relatively easy and quick to obtain. Contact Ms. Kuster (Tel. +41 31 979 11 11, kuster@motorsport.ch) at Auto Sport Schweiz. Cost: CHF 160.00	
FIA HTP	Valid for 10 years. FIA vehicle passport for historic vehicles. Very time-consuming, as the vehicle passport must be approved by various authorities. Contact Ms. Kuster (see FIA HRCP) at Auto Sport Schweiz. Cost: To be agreed upon.
